## \*\*NOTICE TO MOULTON PROPERTY OWNERS\*\*

Property owners or occupants in possession or control of land within the Moulton City Limits, this includes ditches and ag-land, is hereby reminded that it is their responsibility to maintain their land, free from growth of weeds, grasses, vines, brush, etc., of a height that exceeds ten (10) inches and meets the requirements of Section 50.02(9) of the City's Code of Ordinance, or the City will abate the nuisance at the owner's expense and the costs assessed against the property in accordance with Chapter 50 of the Code of Ordinance.

Written notices will be sent out if properties are not maintained giving property owners or occupants five (5) days from the receipt of the notice to comply. Written notice will be given only **ONCE PER CALENDAR**YEAR thereafter the City shall be authorized to enter upon the property for purpose of cutting, destroying and/or removing all weeds in a manner not inconsistent with the term of Chapter 53 of the Code of Ordinance.



2023 Pet Tags are now available. Tags are \$5.00 per pet with a *limit of 5 dogs and/or cats per residence*. Please check and make sure your pet's rabies vaccination is up to date and have the vaccination papers available for the City Clerk to make copies for the City's file. Deadline is May 1, 2023.

#### **DOGS ARE NOT TO BE RUNNING LOOSE!**

ANIMALS ARE TO BE ON A LEASH, CORD, OR CHAIN OR IN A PEN OR HAVE AN ADEQUATE PROTECTIVE FENCE TO PREVENT THE ANIMAL FROM GOING BEYOND THE OWNER'S PROPERTY LINE.

Golf Cart Tags for 2023 are \$5.00, proof of insurance must show the golf cart listed on it. Also, a copy of your Driver's License is required. Children are NOT allowed to drive a golf cart on city streets.

Deadline to have the golf carts licensed is May 1, 2023.

### **OPEN BURNING RESTRICTIONS:**

City Ordinance, Chapter 50.02 NUISANCES ENUMERATED – The following includes, but is not limited to the conditions which are deemed to be nuisances in the City: #8 – Air Pollution. Emission of dense smoke, noxious fumes or fly ash.

City Ordinance, Chapter 105.05 OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED – No person shall allow, cause or permit open burning of combustible materials where the products of combustion are emitted into the open air without passing through a chimney or stack except that open burning is permitted in the following circumstances:

- 2) Trees/Tree Trimmings only at the City-operated burning site conducted by the City.
- 4) Landscape Waste The disposal by open burning of landscape waste originating on the premises. <u>HOWEVER</u>, the burning of landscape waste produced in clearing, grubbing & construction operations shall be limited to areas located at least one-fourth (1/4) mile from any building inhabited by other than the landowner or tenant conducting the open burning.

  Landscape waste may be taken to the brush dump.
