The Moulton City Council met on Monday, June 3, 2024 with the meeting being called to order at 6:00 PM by Mayor Ogden. Roll call - present were Jewel Thompson, Warren Daniels, Susan Fitzgerald, Mary Boyd and Tyler Thompson. Motion by J Thompson seconded by Fitzgerald to approve the agenda, all ayes none opposed.

Motion by Boyd seconded by T Thompson to open the public hearing for the proposed amended budget for 2023/24. All ayes none opposed. No comments made by the public or council via hearing, writing, phone calls, e-mail, or website. Motion by J Thompson seconded by Fitzgerald to close public hearing. All ayes none opposed.

Motion by Boyd seconded by J Thompson to approve Resolution #942, Budget Amendment for 2023/2024. All ayes none opposed.
