The Moulton City Council held a special council meeting Monday, March 24, 2025, at 6:30 PM in the City Hall Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ogden. Roll Call – Present - John Replogle, Jewel Thompson, Terry Pangburn, and Tyler Thompson. Absent – Mary Boyd.

Motion by T Thompson seconded by Replogle to approve the agenda, all ayes none opposed.

Motion by Replogle seconded by J Thompson to have a Public Hearing on April 14, 2025, at 6:00 PM for the 25/26 Budget. All ayes none opposed.

Motion by J Thompson seconded by Pangburn to have a Public Hearing on April 14, 2025, at 6:30 PM for the CDBG Application.

Motion by Replogle seconded by T Thompson to approve CDBG documents: Policy of Prohibition of the Use of Excessive Force, Alternative Signatures, Code of Conduct, Procurement Policies and Procedures for CDBG, Recipient Certification of Procurement Compliance, Fair Housing Policy, Direct Deposit Authorization, Section 3 Requirements, Federal Assurances Signature Page, Applicant/Recipient Disclosure Report, Environmental Review for CDBG Requirements. All ayes, none opposed.

Motion by Pangburn seconded by J Thompson to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 372, Amended Animal Ordinance. Roll Call- Replogle – aye, J Thompson – aye, Pangburn – aye, T Thompson – aye. Motion carried.

Motion by T Thompson seconded by Pangburn to waive the third reading of Ordinance No 372, Amended Animal Ordinance. Roll Call- Replogle – aye, J Thompson – aye, Pangburn – aye, T Thompson – aye. Motion carried.

Motion by J Thompson seconded by Pangburn to approve ICAP Insurance Renewal for FY 25/26. All ayes none opposed.

The Council discussed the pros and cons of having a Peddler's Fee. The Council would like more information from other Cities with the same population numbers as Moulton.

Public Comment – James Welch commented that the food trucks are not in town very often and other businesses are not always open when the trucks are here. People may also want diversity in the food available in town and adding a peddler's fee might drive away the food trucks that are coming now.

Motion by T Thompson seconded by Pangburn to adjourn, all ayes none opposed. Adjourned at 7:10 PM.
