

Water Project Surcharge, Updated Rates & System Improvements

The City of Moulton is moving forward with a major water system improvement project designed to enhance safety, reliability, and long-term compliance with updated state drinking water standards. This project includes **disconnecting the existing water lines under Main Street** and **installing new water lines and fire hydrants in the alleys** to improve access, reduce future maintenance costs, and support better system performance.

To fund this work, the City has implemented a **monthly Water Project Surcharge of \$25.00** on all active water accounts. This surcharge is **restricted solely** to paying for the lead service line replacement project and the loan used to complete it.

Water rates have also been updated to reflect rising costs for water treatment, testing, operations, and regulatory compliance. The current rate structure is:

- **\$36.00** for the minimum **1,000 gallons**
- **\$8.50** for each additional **1,000 gallons** (or portion thereof)

These improvements ensure continued compliance with the Lead & Copper Rule, support long-term system reliability, and strengthen the community's water infrastructure for years to come.
